Founded in 1939, the Institute of Food Technologists (<http://www.ift.org>) is a unique umbrella organization that brings together all the diverse disciplines involved in food technology. It is a scientific and educational society of individual members including:

- Individuals in all food related fields

The **Chicago Section** of the IFT is the largest regional section, currently boasting over 1500 active members. Section activities designed to broaden professional skills and to enrich relations in the food industry include:
